Seniors: You are allowed TWO DAYS your senior year to visit a college/university of your choice! You will need to call the college BEFORE you go to set up a tour!! Go to the college's website and click on the "Admissions" tab for more information or simply look for CAMPUS TOURS! If you need assistance let me know!

Have you taken the ACT?? Reminder for those who registered for the Feb 10th test administration that you must print your ticket before the test date! Let Ms. Channell know if you are testing so she can make you a packet. Remember, if you participate in the free or reduced lunch program, you can get a fee waiver to take the ACT for **free** two times during your high school career. Juniors and seniors will **ALL** test on March 13th here at North Caddo. Pre-coding will be on March 20th so make sure you are in attendance. You can't test if you haven't completed the precoding part. April will be the **LAST** ACT this year if you are trying to get your score up for TOPS. Our high school code for reporting your scores here is: **192-940**. ACT information can be found online at www.actstudent.org

Have you started applying for college admissions? If you send more than one ACT report to any college/university, they are always going to look at your highest score. Can't find a college admissions' website? Submit a yellow slip & I'll help you look! Or you can visit with Ms. Laura from Career Compass in the library.

SENIORS MUST COMPLETE FAFSAs in order to **GRADUATE** this year!! See Ms. Channell if you are unsure if you have done yours or not.

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the **ONLY** way to qualify for Pell Grants or free money from the Federal Government for your college education. The FAFSA is available online starting in October this year. This form is based on your parent/guardians' tax information and is **required for TOPS**. The website is www.fafsa.ed.gov **DO NOT PAY TO FILE THE FAFSA!! IT IS FREE!!**

Louisiana State University-Shreveport has announced an **AWESOME** opportunity for **ALL** students! LSU-S **GUARANTEES** each student a scholarship if you have at least a 24 on your ACT and a 3.0 unweighted Grade Point Average! With at least a 24 on your ACT and 3.0 GPA, students can qualify for \$1,500 a semester. With a 26 on your ACT and a 3.0 unweighted GPA, students can qualify for \$1,800 per semester. With a 30 on your ACT and a 3.5 unweighted GPA, students qualify for **FULL** tuition and fees plus a book allowance each semester. In addition to the guaranteed scholarships, you can add your TOPS, grants, and also apply for other LSU-S scholarships! You could get **PAID** to go to school!!
